Hi there!

1 - I am on a webinar for Staff reporting run by TCCSA - when I brought up the subject of OTC+ because Adult Ed teachers are not to be reported through a CTC STAFF reporting - they were very unclear on how to get the OTC+ staff member reported in their Staff collection to align to what is being reported on the high school side. Could we have very clear guidance on where to enter the OTC+ teacher on the staff reporting side? They advised me to open a ticket and have it escalated to ODE through my ITC. I can do that but it would make it easier if the answer was posted in the documents for everyone to utilize 2 - Funding - since there will be an indicator on the students FS record - would there be a way to separate the OTC+ funds received for those students if not as a line item on the SFPR, but if it could be a collected total on the Restricted funds report - so we know how much needs to be pointed back to the OTC along with trying to determine if the funding received from the state side covers the actual tuition paid to the OTC. We will need to reconcile and justify having OTC+ and will need to easily identify if this new program causes us a budget deficit.

3 - Will our ITCS be given the guidance to update our Student information systems or will we have to wait until this process closes and then for them to build it?

4 - Can it be posted directions on how to enroll a student into the OTC+ that is not from your member school districts AS WELL AS if the student is a home schooled student OR comes to us from a private school. If all of this information was documented in one space in regards to OTC+ it would make it so clear for me to report the students correctly.
