## EMIS Change 25-23

This change updates reporting guidance in the Student Program (GQ) Record for preschool special education students.

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## SECTION 2.9: STUDENT PROGRAM (GQ) RECORD

## Major Program Code Groupings

**Preschool.** For preschool students with disability conditions, itinerant services are those provided by intervention specialists or related services personnel that occur in the setting where the child is located. All preschool students who are receiving itinerant services—regardless of whether they are receiving center-based services—should have one of the following program codes reported to indicate where the student is receiving services, how the services are being provided, and who is providing the services: 220205, 220210, or 220215. For example, if itinerant services are being provided by a speech language pathologist in the child's home, then 220215 would be reported.

In the case of preschool special education itinerant services, the entity that is providing the itinerant education is responsible for reporting the itinerant services program code on the Student Program (GQ) Record.

Special Education Related Services. Report the appropriate related service code(s) as indicated on the child's IEP. Multiple related service program codes may be reported for a child with a disability condition. The EMIS reporting entity (e.g., the resident district or the ESC) providing related services to a preschool child with a disability is required to report the appropriate special education related service program codes. For kindergarten through grade 12 students reported with Disability Condition option 05—Speech and Language Impairments, program code 215013—Speech and Language Services is not reported.
